

Paul's letter to the Galatians

This letter was written by Paul to refute what some Jewish Christians were saying, that the Law of Moses had to be followed; Paul maintained that it was only by following Christ that anyone could be saved.

Paul seemingly wrote this letter about AD 47 before the council meeting in Jerusalem, and it is considered to be one of his earliest letters.

Noteworthy passages are:-

- 1 Living by faith 2 : 19-21
- 2 All are one in Christ 3: 28
- 3 God sent his son 4. 4-5
- 4 The fruit of the Holy Spirit 5: 22-23
